## A BILL

To provide for the rescheduling of marijuana into schedule  
III of the Controlled Substances Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Marijuana 1–to–3 Act  
5 of 2019”.

6 **SECTION 1. RESCHEDULING OF MARIJUANA.**

7 Notwithstanding section 201 and subsections (a) and  
8 (b) of section 202 of the Controlled Substances Act (21  
9 U.S.C. 811, 812) respecting the scheduling of controlled

1 substances, the Attorney General of the United States  
2 shall, by order not later than 60 days after the date of  
3 enactment of this section, transfer marijuana (for pur-  
4 poses of this Act given the same meaning given the term  
5 “marihuana” in section 102 of such Act) from schedule  
6 I of such Act to schedule III of such Act.
